**The Strathclyde Passenger Transport Executive
(Exclusion of Co-operation Requirements)
Order 1986**

Whereas on the 6th day of January 1986 the Secretary of State for Scotland gave to the Strathclyde Passenger Transport Executive (hereinafter called "the Executive") a direction under subsection (3) of section 59 of the Transport Act 1985(a):

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State for Scotland, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 60(2) of that Act and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:—

1. This order may be cited as the Strathclyde Passenger Transport Executive (Exclusion of Co-operation Requirements) Order 1986 and shall come into operation on 26th October 1986.

2. On 25th October 1986 the Executive shall cease to be under the duty imposed by section 24(2) of the Transport Act 1968(b) (duty to co-operate with the National Bus Company and the Scottish Transport Group and to enter into agreements for that purpose).

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This order provides that on 25th October 1986 the Strathclyde Passenger Transport Executive ("the Executive") is to cease to be under the duty imposed by section 24(2) of the Transport Act 1968, to co-operate as to the provision of bus services in their area with the National Bus Company and the Scottish Transport Group and to enter into agreements for that purpose.
