PROCEDURE

The Magistrates' Courts (Forms) (Amendment) Rules 1986

Made -28th July 1986 Laid before Parliament 6th August 1986 1st October 1986 Coming into Operation

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the power conferred on him by section 144 of the Magistrates' Courts Act 1980 (a), as extended by section 145 of that Act, after consultation with the Rule Committee appointed under the said section 144, hereby makes the following Rules:-

- 1.—(1) These Rules may be cited as the Magistrates' Courts (Forms) (Amendment) Rules 1986 and shall come into operation on 1st October 1986.
- (2) In these Rules "the principal Rules" means the Magistrates' Courts (Forms) Rules 1981(b).
 - Schedule 2 to the principal Rules shall be amended as follows—
 - (a) in the form numbered 48 for the words "notice of fine" there shall be substituted the words "[notice of fine] [notice of registration of unpaid fixed penalty as a fine]";
 - (b) in the forms numbered 52, 53, 58, 59, 60 and 63 for the words "convicted on:" there shall be substituted the words "[Convicted on] [Unpaid fixed penalty registered for enforcement as a fine on]:";
 - (c) after the form numbered 157 there shall be inserted the forms numbered 158, 159, 160 and 161 in the Schedule to these Rules.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Rules.)

Part III of the Transport Act 1982 (c.49) makes provision for a new system of fixed penalties which comes into force on 1st October 1986 (S.I. 1986/1326). These Rules make consequential amendments to the Magistrates' Courts (Forms) Rules 1981.

The most important amendment is the insertion of the following four new forms into Schedule 2 to the 1981 Rules:—

- Form 158 Notification to a fixed penalty clerk of registration of unpaid fixed penalty as a fine.
- Form 159 Notice to a defaulter of registration of unpaid fixed penalty as a fine.
- Form 160 Statutory declaration under section 37(2).
- Form 161 Statutory declaration under section 37(3).

The remaining amendments to Forms 48, 52, 53, 58, 59, 60 and 63 are consequential upon the fact that, under Part III, an unpaid fixed penalty may be registered for enforcement as a fine.
