CUSTOMS AND EXCISE

The Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 6) Order 1986

Made - - - 11th August 1986

Coming into Operation 1st September 1986

The Secretary of State, in exercise of powers conferred by section 1 of the Import, Export and Customs Powers (Defence) Act 1939^(a) and now vested in him ^(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the Export of Goods (Control) (Amendment No. 6) Order 1986 and shall come into operation on 1st September 1986.

2. The Export of Goods (Control) Order 1985^(c) shall be further amended as follows:

(a) After Article 2(x) there shall be added the following:

“(xi) scheduled goods indicated by the letters “E(PS)” are prohibited to be exported to any destination except that when in relation to such goods the provisions of Regulation (EEC) 223/77, as amended, relating to the use of Community transit documents requiring anything to be done at or before the time of exportation have been complied with, the goods may be exported to a destination in another Member State, other than Portugal or Spain”;

- (b) for Group A of Part I of Schedule 1 there shall be substituted the new Group A as follows:

“GROUP A

GOODS SPECIFIED BY REFERENCE TO HEADINGS IN

ECONOMIC COMMUNITY

- (c) in Group C of Part I of Schedule 1, the words “except stainless sheet and strip, stainless plate, stainless bar, stainless rod and alloy tool steel” shall be deleted.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Order.)

This Order further amends the Export of Goods (Control) Order 1985.

Export control is:

- (a) *lifted* on certain used or unused iron and steel products in short lengths or in small sizes;
- (b) *extended* on ferrous and alloy scrap to Portugal and Spain;
- (c) *introduced* on certain categories of stainless steel and alloy tool steel to the USA.
