## FUGITIVE CRIMINAL

**The Extradition (Suppression of Terrorism)  
(Amendment) Order 1986**

*Made* - - - - - 12th February 1986  
*Laid before Parliament* 20th February 1986  
*Coming into Operation* 13th March 1986

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 12th day of February 1986

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas Belgium, the Netherlands, Portugal and Switzerland have become parties to the European Convention on the Suppression of Terrorism(a) signed at Strasbourg on 27th January 1977:

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in exercise of the powers conferred upon Her by sections 2 and 21 of the Extradition Act 1870(b), is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. This Order may be cited as the Extradition (Suppression of Terrorism) (Amendment) Order 1986 and shall come into operation on 13th March 1986.

2. The Extradition (Suppression of Terrorism) Order 1978(c) shall be amended by adding to Schedule 2 the following entries:—

Belgium	29th October 1901	1st February 1986
The Netherlands	26th September 1898	19th July 1985
Portugal	17th October 1892	15th March 1982
Switzerland	26th November 1880	20th August 1983

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*(This Note is not part of the Order.)*

This Order applies the Extradition Acts 1870 to 1935 in the case of Belgium, the Netherlands, Portugal and Switzerland, being States party to the European Convention on the Suppression of Terrorism (which was signed at Strasbourg on 27th January 1977), subject to and in accordance with the extradition treaties made with them as amended by the Convention. The Order comes into operation on 13th March 1986.
