**The Legal Advice and Assistance (Scotland) Amendment
(No. 2) Regulations 1986**

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 14A and 15 of the Legal Aid (Scotland) Act 1967(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following regulations:-

1.—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Legal Advice and Assistance (Scotland) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1986 and shall come into operation on 1st May 1986.

(2) In these regulations, the expression “the principal regulations” means the Legal Advice and Assistance (Scotland) Regulations 1973(b).

2. In Schedule 2 to the principal regulations -

(a) in paragraph 1(a) for the sum “£2.10” there shall be substituted the sum “£2.20”;

(b) in paragraph 1(b) for the sums “£13.50”, “£13.50” and “£6.75” there shall be substituted, respectively, the sums “£14.10”, “£14.10” and “£7.05”;

(c) in paragraph 1(c) for the sum “£27” there shall be substituted the sum “£28.20”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These regulations further amend the provisions of the Legal Advice and Assistance (Scotland) Regulations 1973. They amend the sums specified in Schedule 2 to the principal regulations so as to increase the fees allowable to solicitors in respect of work done in connection with the provision of legal advice or assistance by around 4½%.
