**The A523 Derby–Macclesfield–South of Stockport
Trunk Road (Macclesfield Relief Road) Order 1986**

Made - - - - - 26th March 1986
Coming into Operation 15th May 1986

The Secretary of State for Transport makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred by sections 10 and 41 of the Highways Act 1980(a), and now vested in him(b), and of all other enabling powers:—

1. The new highway which the Secretary of State proposes to construct along the route described in the Schedule to this Order shall become a trunk road as from the date on which this Order comes into operation.

2. The centre line of the new trunk road is indicated by a heavy black line on the deposited plan.

3. The Secretary of State directs as respects any part of a highway which crosses the route of the new trunk road that—

(a) where the highway is a highway maintainable at the public expense by a local highway authority, the part in question shall be maintained by that authority; and

(b) where the highway is not a highway so maintainable and is not maintainable under a special enactment or by reason of tenure, enclosure or prescription, the Secretary of State shall be under no duty to maintain the part in question,

until, in either case, a date to be specified in a notice given by the Secretary of State to the highway authority for that highway. The date specified will not be later than the date on which the relevant route is opened for the purpose of through traffic.

4. In this Order:—

All measurements of distance are measured along the route of the relevant highway:

- (i) "the deposited plan" means the plan numbered HA 10/1 CNW188/1 marked "The A523 Derby-Macclesfield-South of Stockport Trunk Road (Macclesfield Relief Road) Order 1986" signed by authority of the Secretary of State and deposited at the Department of Transport, Romney House, Marsham Street, London SW1P 3pY.
- (ii) "the new trunk road" means the highway mentioned in article 1 of this Order; and
- (iii) "the trunk road" means the Derby-Macclesfield-South of Stockport Trunk Road (A523).

5. This Order shall come into operation on 15th May 1986 and may be cited as the A523 Derby-Macclesfield-South of Stockport Trunk Road (Macclesfield Relief Road) Order 1986.

SCHEDULE

ROUTE OF THE NEW TRUNK ROAD

The route of the new Trunk Road is a route at Macclesfield in Cheshire about 2.31 kilometres in length starting at the junction of the new trunk road with Brocklehurst Way, and then going in a general south-westerly and then southerly direction passing to the east of Macclesfield Town Centre and terminating at a point on the trunk road about 45 metres north of its junction with Windmill Street.
