**The Sheffield-Grimsby Trunk Road (A18)
(South Yorkshire) (Detrunking) Order 1986**

Made - - - 21st March 1986
Coming into Operation 25th April 1986

The Secretary of State for Transport makes this order in exercise of powers conferred by sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980(a), and now vested in him(b), and of all other enabling powers:

1. The length of the Trunk Road described in the Schedule to this Order and shown by a series of black dashes on the deposited plan shall cease to be trunk road and shall be classified as principal road as from the date on which this Order comes into operation.

2. In this Order—

(1) all measurements of distance are measured along the route of the relevant highway;

(2) (i) “the deposited plan” means the plan numbered HA10—YH85, marked “The Sheffield—Grimsby Trunk Road (A18) (South Yorkshire) (Detrunking) Order 1986” signed by authority of the Secretary of State and deposited at the Department of Transport, Romney House, Marsham Street, London SW1P 3PY;

(ii) “principal road” as a classification for a highway, means that the highway is a principal road for the purposes of enactments and instruments which refer to highways classified as principal roads and is also classified for the purpose of every other enactment and instrument which refers to highways classified by the Secretary of State; and

(iii) "the Trunk Road"

means the Sheffield-Grimsby Trunk Road (A18).

3. This Order shall come into operation on the 25th April 1986 and may be cited as the Sheffield-Grimsby Trunk Road (A18) (South Yorkshire) (Detrunking) Order 1986.

SCHEDULE

LENGTH OF TRUNK ROAD CEASING TO BE TRUNK ROAD

That length of the Trunk Road which commences at a point 250 metres north east of the eastern side of the roundabout at the eastern end of Wheatley Hall Road, Doncaster, and terminates at, and includes, the roundabout north of Tudworth Lodge Farm, a distance of approximately 10.4 kilometres.
