**The Yorkshire Water Authority
(Gale Gate Drain Discharge) Order 1986**

Made - - - - - 22nd April 1986

Coming into Operation 29th April 1986

The Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 1 of the Water Resources Act 1971(a) and now vested in him(b), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order:—

Citation and commencement

1.— (1) This order may be cited as the Yorkshire Water Authority (Gale Gate Drain Discharge) Order 1986 and shall come into operation on 29th April 1986.

(2) This order shall be included among the enactments which may be cited together as the Yorkshire Water Authority Orders 1974 to 1986.

Discharges of Water

2. The Yorkshire Water Authority may for the purpose of augmenting river flow discharge water from the Upper Dunsforth Borehole into Gale Gate Drain at a discharge point situate at National Grid Reference SE 449 632 at a rate not exceeding 4 thousand cubic metres in any period of 24 hours.
