PUBLIC PASSENGER VEHICLES

**The Public Service Vehicles (Drivers' Licences)
 (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1986**

<i>Made</i> - - - - -	19th May 1986
<i>Laid before Parliament</i>	2nd June 1986
<i>Coming into Operation</i>	1st July 1986

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 52(1)(b) and 60(1) of the Public Passenger Vehicles Act 1981(a), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with representative organisations in accordance with section 61(2) of that Act(b), hereby makes the following Regulations:—

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Public Service Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) (Amendment) (No. 2) Regulations 1986 and shall come into operation on 1st July 1986.

2. The Public Service Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) Regulations 1985(c) shall be further amended in accordance with these Regulations.

3. In regulation 8, for paragraph (d) (viii) there shall be substituted the following paragraph—

“(viii) drive it backwards and whilst doing so cause it to enter a limited opening to the left or to the right and then bring it to rest in a predetermined position.”

4. In paragraph (3) of regulation 10, for the words “£36” there shall be substituted the words “£40”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This Note is not part of the Regulations.)

These Regulations amend the Public Service Vehicles (Drivers' Licences) Regulations 1985, by—

- (a) making a small change in the reversing manoeuvre to be undertaken during the test (regulation 3), and
- (b) increasing the fee for the provision by a traffic commissioner of facilities for an applicant for a licence to drive a public service vehicle to undergo a test from £36 to £40 (regulation 4).
