**THE PERSONAL AND OCCUPATIONAL PENSION
SCHEMES (PROTECTED RIGHTS) REGULATIONS 1987**

1. Citation, commencement and interpretation
 2. Manner of calculation and verification of protected rights mentioned in paragraph 7(2) of Schedule 1 to the Act
 3. Rights which the rules of a scheme may designate as protected rights
 4. Conditions applying to pensions and annuities which give effect to protected rights
 5. Circumstances in which and periods for which pension or annuity is to be paid to widow or widower after being paid to member
 6. Giving effect to protected rights in money purchase contracted-out scheme by providing lump sum
 7. Suspension and forfeiture of payments giving effect to protected rights
 8. Choice of insurance company by annuitant
 9. Insurance companies that may provide protected rights by way of annuities
 10. Death of scheme member before effect given to his protected rights
 11. Enforceable entitlement after death of member
 12. Schemes not to discriminate on grounds of sex or marital status
 13. Personal pension schemes—notifications to the Secretary of State
 14. Occupational pension schemes—notifications to the Secretary of State
