**The Preseli (Communities) Order 1987**

*Made - - - - 30th January 1987*

*Coming into force—*

*For the purposes described  
in article 2(1) 10th February 1987*

*For all other purposes 1st April 1987*

Whereas the Local Government Boundary Commission for Wales, under paragraph 6 of Schedule 10 to the Local Government Act 1972,<sup>(1)</sup> made proposals to the Secretary of State for Wales in relation to communities in the District of Preseli:

And whereas the District Council of Preseli have, by a resolution passed under section 74 of the said Act, resolved that the District shall, as from 1st April 1987, be named the District of Preseli Pembrokeshire:

Now, therefore, the Secretary of State for Wales, in exercise of his powers under paragraph 7 of the said Schedule 10 and section 67(4) and (5) of the said Act as applied by paragraph 9 of the said Schedule, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following order giving effect to the said proposals with modifications:—
