[^{F1}STUDENTS]

Disregard of contribution

67. Where the claimant or his partner is a student and^{F1}, for the purposes of assessing a contribution to the student's grant [^{F2}or student loan], the other partner's income has been taken into account, an amount equal to that contribution shall be disregarded for the purposes of assessing that other partner's income.]
