**CHAPTER VIII**

**[<sup>F1</sup>STUDENTS]**

**Disregard of contribution**

**67.** Where the claimant or his partner is a student and<sup>F1</sup>, for the purposes of assessing a contribution to the student's grant [<sup>F2</sup>or student loan], the other partner's income has been taken into account, an amount equal to that contribution shall be disregarded for the purposes of assessing that other partner's income.]
