CLAIMS

[^{F1}Advance claim for and award of disability working allowance

13B.—(1) Where a person makes a claim for disability working allowance on or after 10th March 1992 and before 7th April 1992 the [^{F2}Secretary of State] may—

- (a) treat the claim as if it were made for a period beginning on 7th April 1992; and
- (b) award benefit accordingly, subject to the condition that the person satisfies the requirements for entitlement on 7th April 1992.

(2) An award under paragraph (1)(b) shall be reviewed by the [^{F2}Secretary of State] if the requirements for entitlement are found not to have been satisfied on 7th April 1992.]
