CLAIMS

Attendance in person

8.—^{F1}(1)

(2) Every person who makes a claim for benefit [^{F2}(other than a jobseeker's allowance)] shall attend at such office or place and on such days and at such times as the Secretary of State [^{F3}or the Board] may direct, for the purpose of furnishing certificates, documents, information and evidence under regulation 7, if reasonably so required by the Secretary of State.
