- 1. This Order may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Confirmation of Legislation) (Gibraltar) Order 1987 and shall come into force on 8th July 1987.
 - 2. The Merchant Shipping (Amendment) Ordinance, 1987(b) is hereby confirmed.
