The A406 London North Circular Trunk Road (Popes Lane (B4491) to Western Avenue (A40) Improvement, Detrunking) Order 1988

Made---1st September 1988Coming into force--15th September 1988

The Secretary of State for Transport makes this Order in exercise of powers conferred on him by sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980(1), and now vested in him(2), and of all other enabling powers:

1. The length of the Trunk Road described in the Schedule to this Order and shown by broad striped hatching on the deposited plan shall cease to be a trunk road as from the date on which the Secretary of State notifies the Council of the London Borough of Ealing that the new trunk road is open for through traffic.

- 2. In this Order—
- (1) all measurements of distance are measured along the route of the relevant highway; and

THE SCHEDULE

LENGTH OF THE TRUNK ROAD CEASING TO BE TRUNK ROAD

A distance of about 300 metres at Hanger Hill in the London Borough of Ealing, from a point approximately 210 metres south of its junction with Brunswick Road (near its northern junction with Chatsworth Road) and extending generally southwards to its junction with Hillcrest Road.
