**MERCHANT SHIPPING**

**The Merchant Shipping (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1988**

*Made* - - - - *11th March 1988*  
*Laid before Parliament* *15th March 1988*  
*Coming into force* - - *5th April 1988*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 33(2) of the Merchant Shipping (Safety Convention) Act 1949<sup>(1)</sup> and now vested in him<sup>(2)</sup> and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and with the approval of the Treasury hereby makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 1988 and shall come into force on 5th April 1988.

2. The Merchant Shipping (Fees) Regulations 1987<sup>(3)</sup> shall be further amended by replacing in Part V the listed fees set out in column 1 of the Table below by those set out in column 2 of that Table.
