**The Town and Country Planning (Compensation for Restrictions
on Mineral Working) (Amendment) Regulations 1988**

The Secretary of State for the Environment as respects England and the Secretary of State for Wales as respects Wales, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 178A of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971((1)) and all other powers enabling them in that behalf, with the consent of the Treasury and after consulting persons and bodies appearing to them to be representative of persons carrying out mining operations, of owners of interests in land containing minerals and of mineral planning authorities, hereby make the following Regulations:—
