#### Citation and interpretation

- 1.—(1) These Rules may be cited as the County Court (Amendment No. 2) Rules 1988.
- (2) In these Rules, unless the context otherwise requires, an Order referred to by number means the Order so numbered in the County Court Rules 1981(1) and Appendix A, B or C means Appendix A, B or C to those Rules.

#### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Rules)

These Rules amend the provisions relating to costs in the County Court Rules 1981 by increasing fixed costs by approximately 5.4% (rules 2 to 4 and 6 to 9) and by introducing a new item for which costs are fixed (rule 5).
