## **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations further amend the Motor Vehicles (Tests) Regulations 1981 so that with effect from 4th July 1988:

- (a) the fee payable for the examination of a motor cycle not having a side car attached to it is increased from £7.48 to £7.92;
- (b) the fee payable for the examination of any other vehicle (not being a vehicle in Class VI) is increased from £12.52 to £13.22;
- (c) the fee for the supply of 100 forms of test certificate is increased from £32 to £37; and
- (d) the fee payable for the issue of a duplicate test certificate for vehicles (other than Class VI vehicles) is increased from £1 to—
  - (i) £3.96 in the case of a motor bicycle not having a side car attached to it, and
  - (ii) £6.61 in any other case.
