BETTING, GAMING AND LOTTERIES

The Gaming Act (Variation of Fees) Order 1989

Made - - - 2nd March 1989

Laid before Parliament 9th March 1989

Coming into force - 1st April 1989

In pursuance of sections 48(5) and 51(4) of the Gaming Act 1968(a), I hereby make the following Order:—

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Gaming Act (Variation of Fees) Order 1989 and shall come into force on 1st April 1989.
 - (2) This Order shall not extend to Scotland.
- 2. The provisions of section 48 of the Gaming Act 1968 specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order (which relate to fees charged in relation to the matters mentioned in column 2 of that Schedule) shall have effect as if, for the references to the sums specified in those provisions (for which the sums mentioned in column 3 of that Schedule were substituted by the Gaming Act (Variation of Fees) (No. 2) Order 1988(b)), there were substituted references to the sums specified in column 4 of that Schedule.
 - 3. The Gaming Act (Variation of Fees) (No. 2) Order 1988 is hereby revoked.
