Railway No. 1

That part of the railway between Aberystwyth and Devil's Bridge in the county of Dyfed as is situate at, and adjacent to, Aberystwyth station and which, with the lands relating thereto, is more particularly delineated and coloured pink on the plan marked "The British Railways Board (Vale of Rheidol) Light Railway (Amendment) Order 1989—Railway No. 1 (Aberystwyth Station)", deposited with the Secretary of State at his office at 2 Marsham Street, London SW1P 3EB, where it is open to inspection free of charge during office hours.

Railway No. 2

So much of the railway between Aberystwyth and Devil's Bridge authorised by the Vale of Rheidol (Light) Railway Act 1897 and constructed and worked as a light railway under the Vale of Rheidol Light Railway (Amendment) Order 1902 as commences at National Grid reference point SN 5896:8110 and forms the eastern continuation to Devil's Bridge of Railway No. 1
