**The Police Cadets (Scotland) Amendment (No.2)  
Regulations 1990**

*Made* - - - - - *17th October 1990*

*Laid before Parliament* *30th October 1990*

*Coming into force* *21st November 1990*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 27 of the Police (Scotland) Act 1967(a), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and after taking into consideration the recommendations made by the Police Negotiating Board for the United Kingdom and furnishing the said Board with a draft of the Regulations in accordance with section 2(1) of the Police Negotiating Board Act 1980(b), hereby makes the following Regulations:

**Citation**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Police Cadets (Scotland) Amendment (No.2) Regulations 1990.

**Commencement**

2. These Regulations shall come into force on 21st November 1990 and shall have effect for the purposes of regulation 4 as from 1st September 1990.

**Interpretation**

3. In these Regulations any reference to "the principal Regulations" is a reference to the Police Cadets (Scotland) Regulations 1968(c).

**Amendment of the principal Regulations**

4. For the Table in Schedule 1 to the principal Regulations (which contains scales of pay) there is substituted the following Table:-

<i>Age</i>	<i>Annual Pay</i>
Under 17 years	£4,002
17 years	£4,245
18 years or over	£4,725

---

5. In Schedule 2 to the principal Regulations (which relates to charges for board and lodging), for the sum "£516" there is substituted the sum "£558".

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations further amend the Police Cadets (Scotland) Regulations 1968.

Regulation 4 increases the pay of police cadets with retrospective effect from 1st September 1990. Retrospection is authorised by section 27(2) of the Police (Scotland) Act 1967.

Regulation 5 increases the charges payable by cadets for board and lodging provided by police authorities from £516 per annum to £558 per annum with effect from 21st November 1990.
