APPENDIX

THE DYFED-POWYS POLICE AMALGAMATION (AMENDMENT) SCHEME 1990

- 1. This Scheme may be cited as the Dyfed-Powys Police Amalgamation (Amendment) Scheme 1990 and shall come into force on 1st April 1990.
- 2. For paragraph 3(3) of Schedule 2 to the Dyfed-Powys Police Amalgamation Scheme 1973 there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraph—
 - "(3) For the purposes of the foregoing sub-paragraph the population of an area shall be the "relevant population" calculated in accordance with section 69(7) of the Local Government Finance Act 1988(c) and regulations made thereunder.".
