## The Occupational Pension Schemes (Revaluation) Regulations 1991

## Benefits consisting of two or more components

5.-(1) This regulation applies to any benefit consisting partly of a component to which [ ${ }^{\mathrm{F} 1}$ the final salary method, within the meaning of paragraph 1 of Schedule 3 to the Act, applies and partly of a component to which that method] does not apply.
(2) [ ${ }^{\mathrm{F} 2}$ Paragraph 1 of Schedule 3 to the Act] is modified so that, for the purpose of revaluing the component to which ${ }^{[2}$ the final salary method applies, the pensionable service and the amount of pension or other benefit referred to in sub-paragraph (1) of that paragraph] are to be calculated by reference only to the component to which [ ${ }^{\mathrm{F} 2}$ that method] applies and the pensionable service which qualified the member for that component.
