The Extradition (Protection of Nuclear Material) Order 1991

1. This Order may be cited as the Extradition (Protection of Nuclear Material) Order 1991, and shall come into force on the date, to be notified in the London, Edinburgh and Belfast Gazettes, on which the Convention on the Physical Protection of Nuclear Material enters into force for the United Kingdom.

2. Schedule 1 to the Extradition Act 1989 (“the 1989 Act”) shall apply in the case of a State mentioned in Schedule 2 to this Order under and in accordance with the extradition treaties listed in the second column of that Schedule as supplemented by paragraphs 1 and 4 of Article 11 of the Convention (set out in Schedule 1 to this Order); the Orders in Council which give effect to the said extradition treaties shall be construed accordingly. The convention entered into force for those States on the dates specified in the third column of the said Schedule 2.

3. The 1989 Act, so far as it relates to extradition procedures under Part III of that Act, shall apply in the case of a State mentioned in Part I of Schedule 3 to this Order (being States in respect of which the Convention entered into force on the dates specified in the second column of Part I of that Schedule) subject to the limitations, restrictions, exceptions and qualifications contained in Part II of that Schedule.

4. The operation of this Order is limited to the United Kingdom, the Channel Islands and the Isle of Man.
