**The Residential Care Homes (Amendment) Regulations 1991**

**Amendment of Schedule 1 to the principal Regulations**

**4.** In Schedule 1 to these Regulations (information to be supplied on an application for registration) after paragraph 2 there shall be inserted—

“**2A.** An applicant for registration who is the intended manager of the home (whether or not he is in control of it) shall—

- (a) supply in writing to the registration authority details with respect to his criminal convictions (if any);
- (b) where the registration authority ask him for details of any criminal convictions which are spent convictions within the meaning of section 1 of the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974<sup>(1)</sup> and inform him at the time the question is asked that, by virtue of the Rehabilitation of Offenders Act 1974 (Exceptions) Order 1975<sup>(2)</sup> spent convictions are to be disclosed, supply in writing to the registration authority details of those convictions.”
