**The Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (Lead in Cattle)(England) (Revocation) (No. 2) Order 1991**

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 1(1) and (2) and section 24(1) of the Food and Environment Protection Act 1985<sup>(1)</sup>, and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

**Title and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (Lead in Cattle) (England) (Revocation) (No. 2) Order 1991 and shall come into force on 16th March 1991.

**Revocation**

2. The Food Protection (Emergency Prohibitions) (Lead in Cattle)(England) Order 1991<sup>(2)</sup> is hereby revoked.
