The A18 Trunk Road (Barnetby Top to East of Ermine Street)(Detrunking) Order 1991

Made - - - - - *25th March 1991*
Coming into force - - - - - *3rd May 1991*

The Secretary of State for Transport makes this Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 10 and 12 of the Highways Act 1980⁽¹⁾, and now vested in him⁽²⁾, and all other enabling powers:

1. The length of the Trunk Road described in the Schedule to this Order and shown by broad striped hatching on the deposited plan shall cease to be a trunk road and shall be classified as a principal road as from the date on which this Order comes into force.

2. In this Order

- (i) “the deposited plan” means the plan numbered HA10-YHNMD4 marked “The A18 Trunk Road (Barnetby Top to East of Ermine Street)(Detrunking) Order 1991” signed by authority of the Secretary of State and deposited at the Department of Transport, Romney House, 43 Marsham Street, London SW1P 3PY;
- (ii) “principal road” as a classification for a highway, means that the highway is a principal road for the purposes of enactments and instruments which refer to highways classified as principal roads and is also classified for the purpose of every other enactment and instruments which refer to highways classified by the Secretary of State;
- (iii) “the Trunk Road” means the A18 Trunk Road.

3. This Order shall come into force on 3rd May 1991 and may be cited as the A18 Trunk Road (Barnetby Top to East of Ermine Street) (Detrunking) Order 1991.

SCHEDULE

LENGTH OF THE TRUNK ROAD CEASING TO BE A TRUNK ROAD

That length of the Trunk Road which extends from its junction with Barton Street (A18) at Barnetby Top (marked "A" on the deposited plan) in a south westerly direction to its junction with Ermine Street (Roman Road) south of Broughton (marked "B" on the deposited plan) all in the County of Humberside, a distance of 8.05 kilometres.
