The International Carriage of Perishable Foodstuffs (Amendment) Regulations 1992

Made	28th October 1992
Laid before Parliament	5th November 1992
Coming into force	1st December 1992

The Secretary of State for Transport in exercise of the powers conferred on him by sections 3(1), 4(1) and 19(1)(1) of the International Carriage of Perishable Foodstuffs Act 1976(2), and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Regulations:

1. These Regulations shall come into force on 1st December 1992 and may be cited as the International Carriage of Perishable Foodstuffs (Amendment) Regulations 1992.

2. For the Schedule to the International Carriage of Perishable Foodstuffs Regulations 1985(**3**) there shall be substituted the Schedule to these Regulations.

(Testing)

1. Fee for the testing of a unit of transport equipment £150

2. Fee for the use of the facilities of a designated station for each day, or part of a day, in which such facilities are used for the purpose of the testing of a unit of transport equipment $\dots \pm 2365$

3. Fee for the certification of a unit of transport equipment which has been tested £50

PART II

(Type Approval)

1. Fee for the testing of a unit of transport equipment as a type vehicle and the inspection of arrangements for ensuring conformity of production $\dots \dots \pounds 850$

2. Fee for the use of the facilities of a designated station for each day, or part of a day, in which such facilities are used for the purpose of the testing of a unit of transport equipment as a type vehicle $\dots \pm 1365$

3. Fee for the certification of a type vehicle £245

4. Fee for the certification of a vehicle which a certifying officer is satisfied conforms with a type vehicle $\dots \dots \pm 50$

PART III

(Examination)

1. Fee for the examination at the Refrigerated Vehicle Test Centre of a unit of transport equipment £55

2. Fee for the examination at a place other than the Refrigerated Vehicle Test Centre of a unit of transport equipment—

- (a) for up to four units presented at the same time for examination, for each unit $\dots \pm 160$
- (b) for each additional unit £40

3. Fee for the certification of a unit of transport equipment which has been examined £50

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations change most of the fees charged under the International Carriage of Perishable Foodstuffs Regulations 1985, as amended by the International Carriage of Perishable Foodstuffs (Amendment) Regulations 1987, for testing, type approval and examination of goods vehicles, railway wagons and containers carrying perishable foodstuffs on international journeys.
