## **MEDICINES**

The Medicines (Exemption from Licensing)
(Radiopharmaceuticals) Order 1992

Made - - - - 12th November 1992
Laid before Parliament 20th November 1992
Coming into force - - 11th December 1992

The Secretaries of State respectively concerned with health in England, in Wales and in Scotland and the Department of Health and Social Services for Northern Ireland acting jointly in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 15(1) of the Medicines Act 1968(1) or, as the case may be, those conferred by that provision and now exercisable by them(2) and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, after consultation with such organisations as appear to them to be representative of interests likely to be substantially affected by this Order(3), hereby make the following Order:
