**The Social Security (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidation Benefit) Amendment Regulations 1992**

**Amendment of regulation 12D of the Social Security (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidation Benefit) Regulations 1983**

2. For sub-paragraph (c) of paragraph (2) of regulation 12D of the Social Security (Unemployment, Sickness and Invalidation Benefit) Regulations 1983<sup>(1)</sup> (persons deemed to be actively seeking employment) there shall be substituted the following sub-paragraph—

“(c) if he is a blind person, a maximum of 6 weeks, whether consecutive or not, during which, apart from a period of no more than 2 weeks, he participates for a maximum period of 4 weeks in a course of training in the use of guide dogs of which at least 3 days in each such week is spent in that training.”.
