1. These Regulations may be cited as the Social Security (Claims and Payments) Amendment (No. 2) Regulations 1992 and shall come into force on 1st April 1993.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend paragraph 7 of Schedule 9A to the Social Security (Claims and Payments) Regulations 1987 by reducing from $\pounds 2.50$ to $\pounds 1.00$ the fee which qualifying lenders pay for the purpose of defraying administrative expenses incurred by the Secretary of State in making payments in respect of mortgage interest direct to qualifying lenders.
