ROAD TRAFFIC

The A12 Trunk Road (Eastern Avenue East and Eastern Avenue West, Havering) (Prescribed Routes) Order 1992

Made - - - - *16th March 1992*
Coming into force - - *23rd March 1992*

The Secretary of State for Transport, in exercise of his powers conferred by section 6(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(1), and of all other enabling powers, and after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis pursuant to section 7(6) of that Act(2), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A12 Trunk Road (Eastern Avenue East and Eastern Avenue West, Havering) (Prescribed Routes) Order 1992 and shall come into force on 23rd March 1992.

2. In this Order—

“Eastern Avenue East” and “Eastern Avenue West” mean those lengths of the A12 trunk road in the London Borough of Havering known by those names;

“northeastern traffic island” means the island site in the westbound carriageway of Eastern Avenue East which extends to the junction from a point 17 metres northeast of the junction;

“southwestern traffic island” means the island site in the eastbound carriageway of Eastern Avenue West which extends to the junction from a point 17 metres southwest of the junction; and

“the junction” means the junction of Eastern Avenue East and Eastern Avenue West with the highways known as Havering Road (B175) and North Street (A125).

3. Every person causing or permitting a vehicle to pass to the right of the southwestern traffic island—

(a) shall cause that vehicle to turn right into North Street; or

(b) is permitted to cause that vehicle to make a U-turn at the junction in order to proceed in Eastern Avenue West in the opposite direction.

4. Every person causing or permitting a vehicle to pass to the right of the northeastern traffic island—

- (a) shall cause that vehicle to turn right into Havering Road; or
 - (b) is permitted to cause that vehicle to make a U-turn at the junction in order to proceed in Eastern Avenue East in the opposite direction.
5. Save as provided in articles 3 and 4 above, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in Eastern Avenue East or Eastern Avenue West to make a right turn or a U-turn at the junction.
6. Nothing in this Order shall apply to—
- (a) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes; or
