SCHEDULE 4

RULES OF PROCEDURE APPLICABLE TO APPEALS AGAINST IMPROVEMENT AND PROHIBITION NOTICES

Expenses

12.—(1) A tribunal may make an order that a party shall pay to another party either a specified sum in respect of the expenses of or in connection with an appeal incurred by that other party or, in default of agreement, the taxed amount of those expenses.

(2) Any expenses required by an order under this rule to be taxed may be taxed according to such part of the table of fees prescribed for proceedings in the sheriff court as shall be directed by the order, and thereafter the tribunal may issue an order for payment of the amount as taxed.
