The Local Government Finance (Scotland) Order 1993

Approved by the House of Commons

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by paragraph 1 of Schedule 12 to the Local Government Finance Act 1992(1) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, and after consultation with such associations of local authorities as appear to him to be appropriate in accordance with paragraph 2(2) of that Schedule, and with the consent of the Treasury, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Government Finance (Scotland) Order 1993 and shall come into force on the day after the day on which it is approved by a resolution of the House of Commons.

Revenue support grant for 1993-94

2.—(1) The local authorities to which revenue support grant is payable in respect of the financial year 1993-94 are specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order.

(2) The amount of the revenue support grant payable to each local authority specified in column 1 of Schedule 1 to this Order in respect of the financial year 1993-94 shall be the amount determined in relation to that local authority set out in column 2 of that Schedule opposite the name of that local authority.

Distribution of non-domestic rate income for 1993-94

3.—(1) The local authorities among whom the distributable amount of non-domestic rate income is distributed in respect of the financial year 1993-94 are specified in column 1 of Schedule 2 to this Order.

(2) The amount of non-domestic rate income distributed to each local authority specified in column 1 of Schedule 2 to this Order in respect of the financial year 1993-94 shall be that part of
