The Secretary of State for Social Security, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 67(2), 72(8), 123(1), 130(2) and (4), 135(1), 136(5)(b), 137(1) and (2)(c) and 175(1) to (5) of the Social Security Contributions and Benefits Act 1992^{M1}, sections 73(1)(b) and 189(1) and (3) to (6) of the Social Security Administration Act 1992^{M2} and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, so far as these Regulations relate to housing benefit after consultation with organisations appearing to him to be representative of the authorities concerned^{M3}, and after agreement by the Social Security Advisory Committee that proposals in respect of these Regulations should not be referred to it^{M4} hereby makes the following Regulations:
