**The Walsgrave Hospital National Health  
Service Trust Dissolution Order 1993**

*Made* - - - - *19th March 1993*

*Coming into force* - - *1st April 1993*

The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of powers conferred on her by section 126(3) of the National Health Service Act 1977<sup>(1)</sup> and section 5(1) of, and paragraph 29(1) of Schedule 2 to, the National Health Service and Community Care Act 1990<sup>(2)</sup> and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, on the application of the NHS trust concerned<sup>(3)</sup>, and after completion of the consultation, prescribed under paragraph 29(3) of Schedule 2 to that latter Act<sup>(4)</sup>, hereby makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Walsgrave Hospital National Health Service Trust Dissolution Order 1993 and shall come into force on 1st April 1993.

**Dissolution of NHS Trust**

2. The Walsgrave Hospital National Health Service Trust is hereby dissolved, and accordingly the Walsgrave Hospital National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Order 1991<sup>(5)</sup> is hereby revoked.
