The Community Health Care: North Durham National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 1994

The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of powers conferred on her by section 126(3) of the National Health Service Act 1977(1) and section 5(1) of the National Health Service and Community Care Act 1990(2) and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Community Health Care: North Durham National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 1994, and shall come into force on 10th February 1994.

Amendment of Establishment Order

2. In sub–paragraph (a) of article 3(2) of the Community Health Care: North Durham National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Order 1993(3) (functions of the trust) for the words "Dryburn Hospital, Durham DH1 5TW" there shall be substituted the words "County Hospital, Durham DH1 4ST".
