**The Central Scotland Healthcare National Health
Service Trust (Appointment of Trustees) Order 1994**

Made - - - - *15th September 1994*

Coming into force - - *1st October 1994*

The Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 12G(2) of the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978(1), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Central Scotland Healthcare National Health Service Trust (Appointment of Trustees) Order 1994, and shall come into force on 1st October 1994.

(2) In this Order—

“the Act” means the National Health Service (Scotland) Act 1978;

“the Trust” means the Central Scotland Healthcare National Health Service Trust.

Appointment of trustees

2. The chairman, non-executive directors and executive directors of the Trust are appointed trustees *ex officio* for the purpose of holding any property which is to be held in trust on behalf of the Trust under section 12G of the Act.
