**The Former Yugoslavia (United Nations  
Sanctions) (Isle of Man) Order 1994**

**Provision relating to articles 4, 5 and 6**

**8.—(1)** The provisions of articles 5 and 6 shall apply to any person within the Isle of Man and to any person elsewhere who:

- (a) is a British citizen, a British Dependent Territories citizen, a British Overseas citizen, a British subject, or a British protected person and is ordinarily resident in the Isle of Man; or
- (b) is a body incorporated or constituted under the law of the Isle of Man.

(2) Subject to the provisions of paragraphs (3) and (4) below, any person specified in paragraph (1) above who contravenes the provisions of articles 5(1) or 6(1), and any person who contravenes the provisions of article 4(1), shall be guilty of an offence.

(3) In the case of proceedings for an offence in contravention of article 4(1) by a person or body acting on behalf of a body in the Bosnian Serb controlled areas or any of the bodies described in article 4(2)(b)(i), it shall be a defence for the accused person to prove that he did not know and had no reason to suppose that he was so acting.

(4) In the case of proceedings for an offence in contravention of article 5(1), it shall be a defence for the accused person to prove that he did not know and had no reason to suppose that the services in question were to be provided for the purposes of any business carried on in the Bosnian Serb controlled areas.
