The Merchant Shipping (Seamen~s Wages and Accounts) (Amendment) Regulations 1994

Made - - - - 16th March 1994
Laid before Parliament 23rd March 1994
Coming into force - - 13th April 1994

The Secretary of State, after consulting with the organisations referred to in section 99(2) of the Merchant Shipping Act 1970(1), in exercise of powers conferred by section 9 of that Act and now vested in him(2), and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, hereby makes the following Regulations:

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Merchant Shipping (Seamen's Wages and Accounts) (Amendment) Regulations 1994 and shall come into force on 13th April 1994.
- **2.** The Merchant Shipping (Seamen's Wages and Accounts) Regulations 1972(**3**) shall be further amended by the substitution for regulation 6 of the following:
 - "6. The maximum amount which may be deducted from a seaman's wages in respect of any number of breaches of his obligations under the crew agreement—
 - (a) by virtue of regulation 5(c), shall be £300; and
 - (b) by virtue of regulation 5(d), shall be £300.".

These Regulations further amend the Merchant Shipping (Seamen's Wages and Accounts) Regulations 1972 by increasing from £200 to £300 the maximum deduction an employer may make from wages in respect of certain breaches of the crew agreement.
