 - (a) section 26(2) (prohibition on registration of certain names except with the approval of the Secretary of State);
 - (b) section 244(5) (extension by Secretary of State of the period allowed for laying and delivering accounts and reports); and
 - (c) section 702(5) (extension by Secretary of State of period for delivering accounts and reports of an overseas company).
