SCHEDULE Article 2

MODIFICATIONS IN THE EXTENSION OF THE ANTARCTIC ACT 1994 TO GUERNSEY

- **1.** Any reference to an enactment shall be construed, unless the contrary intention appears, as a reference to that enactment as it has effect in the Bailiwick of Guernsey.
- **2.** In sections 3(3), 3(7), 17, 21, 22(1), 23(1) and 24, for "the United Kingdom" in each place where those words occur there is substituted "the Bailiwick of Guernsey".
 - **3.** In section 31(1), in the definition of "United Kingdom national", at the end there is added:
 - "(f) a body incorporated under the law of any part of the Bailiwick of Guernsey;."
 - **4.** In section 32, subsection (3) is omitted.
- **5.** In the Schedule, the entries relating to the Antarctic Minerals Act 1989(1) and the Law Reform (Miscellaneous Provisions) (Scotland) Act 1990(2) are omitted.
