Made - - - - 28th June 1995

Coming into force in accordance with article 1(2)

At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 28th of June 1995

Present,

The Queen's Most Excellent Majesty in Council

Whereas in pursuance of section 3(1) of the Parliamentary Constituencies Act 1986⁽¹⁾, the Boundary Commission for England have submitted to the Secretary of State a report dated 12th April 1995 showing the constituencies into which they recommend, in accordance with that Act, that England should be divided;

And whereas the Secretary of State has laid the report before Parliament together with the draft of this Order in Council to give effect, without modifications, to the recommendations contained in the report and each House of Parliament has by resolution approved the said draft;

Now, therefore, Her Majesty, in pursuance of section 4 of the Parliamentary Constituencies Act 1986, is pleased, by and with the advice of Her Privy Council, to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Parliamentary Constituencies (England) Order 1995.
(2) Subject to section 4(6) of the Parliamentary Constituencies Act 1986, this Order shall come into force on the fourteenth day after the day on which it is made.
- 2.—(1) For all the constituencies in England there shall be substituted the constituencies which—
 - (a) are named in the left-hand column of the Schedule to this Order;
 - (b) are designated in that column as either county constituencies or borough constituencies;and

- (c) comprise the areas set out in the right-hand column of that Schedule.
- (2) The areas set out in the right-hand column of the Schedule to this Order are local government areas as they existed on 1st June 1994.
- 3.** Every electoral registration officer shall make such re-arrangement or adaptation of the register of parliamentary electors as may be necessary to give effect to this Order.

(This note is not part of the Order)

This Order gives effect without modification to the recommendations set out in the report of the Boundary Commission for England dated 12th April 1995. The report sets out proposals for parliamentary constituencies in England consequent on a review by the Commission of the representation in the House of Commons of England.

Article 2 of, and the Schedule to, this Order give effect to those proposals. By virtue of section 4(6) of the Parliamentary Constituencies Act 1986, the coming into force of this Order does not affect any parliamentary election until a proclamation is issued by Her Majesty summoning a new Parliament, or affect the constitution of the House of Commons until the dissolution of the Parliament then in being.
