**The Children (Allocation of Proceedings) (Amendment) Order 1995**

The Lord Chancellor, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by Part I of Schedule 11 to the Children Act 1989(1), hereby makes the following Order—

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Children (Allocation of Proceedings) (Amendment) Order 1995 and shall come into force on 2nd October 1995.

**2.** In Schedule 1 to the Children (Allocation of Proceedings) Order 1991(2) (“the 1991 Order”), under the heading “**Wales and Chester Circuit**”, after “Newport (Gwent) County Court” there shall be inserted “Pontypridd County Court”.

**3.** In column (ii) of Schedule 2 to the 1991 Order, for “Merthyr Tydfil County Court” wherever it appears, there shall be substituted “Pontypridd County Court”.
