**The Royal Orthopaedic Hospital National Health  
Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 1995**

The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of powers conferred on her by section 126(3) of the National Health Service Act 1977<sup>(1)</sup> and section 5(1) of the National Health Service and Community Care Act 1990<sup>(2)</sup> and of all other powers enabling her in that behalf, hereby makes the following Order:

**Citation and commencement**

1. This Order may be cited as the Royal Orthopaedic Hospital National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Amendment Order 1995 and shall come into force on 15th July 1995.

**Amendment of NHS trust Establishment Order**

2. In Article 4 of the Royal Orthopaedic Hospital National Health Service Trust (Establishment) Order 1995<sup>(3)</sup> for “4 non-executive” there shall be substituted “5 non-executive” and for “4 executive” there shall be substituted “5 executive”.
