**The Tameside and Glossop Community and
Priority Services National Health Service
Trust (Transfer of Trust Property) Order 1995**

The Secretary of State for Health, in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 92(1) of the National Health Service Act 1977(1) and of all other powers enabling him in that behalf, having regard to the change in the arrangements for the administration of hospitals and other establishments and facilities formerly managed by the Tameside and Glossop Health Authority resulting from the establishment of the Tameside and Glossop Community and Priority Services National Health Service Trust(2), having consulted the West Pennine Health Authority(3) and that Trust in accordance with section 92(3) of that Act, hereby makes the following Order:

Citation, commencement and interpretation

1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Tameside and Glossop Community and Priority Services National Health Service Trust (Transfer of Trust Property) Order 1995 and shall come into force on 8th August 1995.

(2) In this Order—

“the Authority” means the West Pennine Health Authority;

“the Trust” means the Tameside and Glossop Community and Priority Services National Health Service Trust;

“the trust property” means the items specified in a schedule of trust property prepared by and agreed upon by the Authority and the Trust on 13th March 1995, which schedule has been signed on behalf of both the Authority and the Trust.
