Article 7

Coney Green Crossing Safety Devices to be Provided and Safety Requirements to be Observed

1. Wicket gates (“the gates”) shall be provided across the footpath on either side of the railway opening away from the railway.
2. The gates shall be so constructed as (when closed) to close off the railway.
3. The Society may remove the gates at times when they are not operating the railway provided that they replace the gates before the railway is next operated.
4. The gates must not be locked at any time.
5. The Society shall provide trained staff to open and close the gates at all times when the railway is being operated, and shall instruct such staff to ensure that the level crossing is clear of pedestrians before the passage of any train.
6. A sign bearing the words “Stop, Look, Listen, Beware of Trains” shall be provided on the left-hand side of the footpath on either side of the railway and shall face towards persons approaching the level crossing.
